10-12	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ☉ 1st FFL Class "Toulon campus" <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ The first part of this FFL class aims at acquainting the students with our city center campus. ○ The second part prepares the students for their cultural afternoon field trip to the city center of Toulon and provides them with an elementary French MM vocabulary for the subsequent MM class.

14-16	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◎ 1st MM Class "Introduction to Telomedia" <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ The first part of this MM class teaches the students the basic techniques required to shoot their film during their field trips. ○ The second part is devoted to a first introduction to Telomedia.
16-18	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◎ 1st Field trip "Toulon and its surroundings" <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ The first local field trip is designed to discover the cultural neighborhood of the city center of Toulon. ○ During the field trip, the students shoot the first parts of their film.

09-12	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◎ 2nd FFL Class "French language and culture" <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ The first part of this FFL class works on the linguistic content of the field trip of the previous day. ○ During the second part, the students discover new elements of the French culture.
14-18	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◎ 2nd MM Class "Multimedia basics on Telomedia" <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ This MM class teaches the students how to use the equipment of Telomedia. In particular, they learn some key elements about green set shooting, video editing, video control systems, post-production, and voice-over recording. ○ This class also includes practical exercises.

11-18	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◎ 2nd Field trip "Provence and its natural environment" <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Field trip to the Porquerolles island. ○ During the field trip, the students shoot parts of their film.

09-12	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◎ 4th FFL Class "Practical applications" <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ The first part of this FFL class works on the linguistic content of the field trip of the previous day. ○ During the second part, the students prepare the linguistic elements required for the afternoon field trip.
14-18	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◎ 3rd Field trip "Provence and its cities" <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Visit of Marseilles. ○ During the field trip, the students complete the shooting of their film.

14-18	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ⊙ 3nd MM Class “Green set shooting” <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ During this MM class, on Telomedia, the students do their green set shooting, add the desired special effects, and do the video editing. ○ The students have the possibility to add selected elements from our immersive environment to supplement their news broadcast.
